



# iPad Rules

## Student Daily Responsibilities

Please make these behaviours a part of your routine. If you forget to do these things, you will first receive a warning. Upon your third warning you will lose the privilege of using your iPad at school.

- iPads should be used for educational purposes only during school hours.
- iPads should never be left unattended.
- iPads should always remain in the case.
- Arrive at school every day with a fully charged battery.
- Always place the iPad on a stable surface to use it.
- Make sure your iPad isn't distracting you or others in the classroom (for example; games, sounds or screen effects).
- Keep all food and drink away from your iPad.
- The iPad is your responsibility; do not allow anyone to use your device at **any time**.
- iPads are to stay in the "home" area, unless being used.
- You must be sitting at your desk when using iPads, unless the lesson requires you to go elsewhere.
- When the signal is given you have 30 seconds to return iPads to the "home" area.
- No inappropriate changes to the iPads will take place by the student (i.e. deleting apps, changing ID#s) OR visiting of POP-UP Ads.
- **Please bring in headphones to listen to audio.**

### Good Citizenship

Please use your iPad as a responsible student. If you fail to do so, you will lose the right to use this educational tool.

- Students should read and follow Mother Teresa's Technology Acceptable Use Policy signed by parents and student.
- Students should remember to stay on task in class. Use the iPad only for activities that the teacher approves.
- During school hours, visit only those websites approved by the teacher or related to the topic the teacher assigns.
- If you accidentally visit a website with inappropriate content, hit the back button and let your teacher know as soon as possible.

### Unacceptable Behaviour

The following behaviour is unacceptable. You will lose the right to use your iPad for an extended period of time as determined by your teacher and parents.

- Using the iPad camera to take, forward or view inappropriate pictures or movies.
- Using the iPad for capturing, forwarding or viewing an image of someone without their knowledge.
- Intentionally visiting websites with inappropriate content.
- Accessing another student's personal account/s or impersonating someone using their information.
- Deleting history or intentionally trying to cover up inappropriate use.
- Intentionally damaging, placing stickers, writing, drawing on or otherwise defacing the iPad or case.
- Tampering with any restricted codes that have been set on the iPad.
- Setting a passcode without your parents' permission and keeping the information from them. Parents must have your current login password and any other password accounts.
